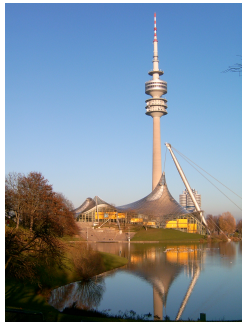
## ► Munich is the capital of Bavaria in southern Germany

- with 1.38 million inhabitants largest city in Bavaria and third largest in Germany (after Berlin and Hamburg)
- 3 universities (LMU, TUM and BW), 4 Max Planck Institutes, etc.
- Many large companies (Allianz, BMW, Linde, MAN, Infineon, Munich Re, Siemens)
- Art Museums: Old and New Pinakothek and Pinakothek of the Modern and others
- World oldest and largest science museum: German Museum
- Olympic stadion (1972 summer olympics) and Allianz Arena (new soccer stadium)
- International Airport (MUC) 30 min train ride from the city
- And of course: white sausages and Beer





# Munich





- ▶ Workshop will be from 8 - 12 September 2014 and it will be held in the Auditorium of the Max-Planck-Inst. für Physik in Munich (MPP).
  - This is the 10th ATLAS Hadronic Calibration Workshop (HCW) following the last year workshop in Chicago
  - The 2nd HCW took place at MPP in 2006
  - The local organizing committee for the HCW 2014 in Munich is composed by: T. Barillari, A. Kiryunin, S. Menke, M. Nagel, D. Salihagic, P. Schacht, A. Schielke, A. Wildauer
  - Conference fee estimate currently around 250 € (150 € for students)

- Outside the main building of Max Planck Institute for Physics



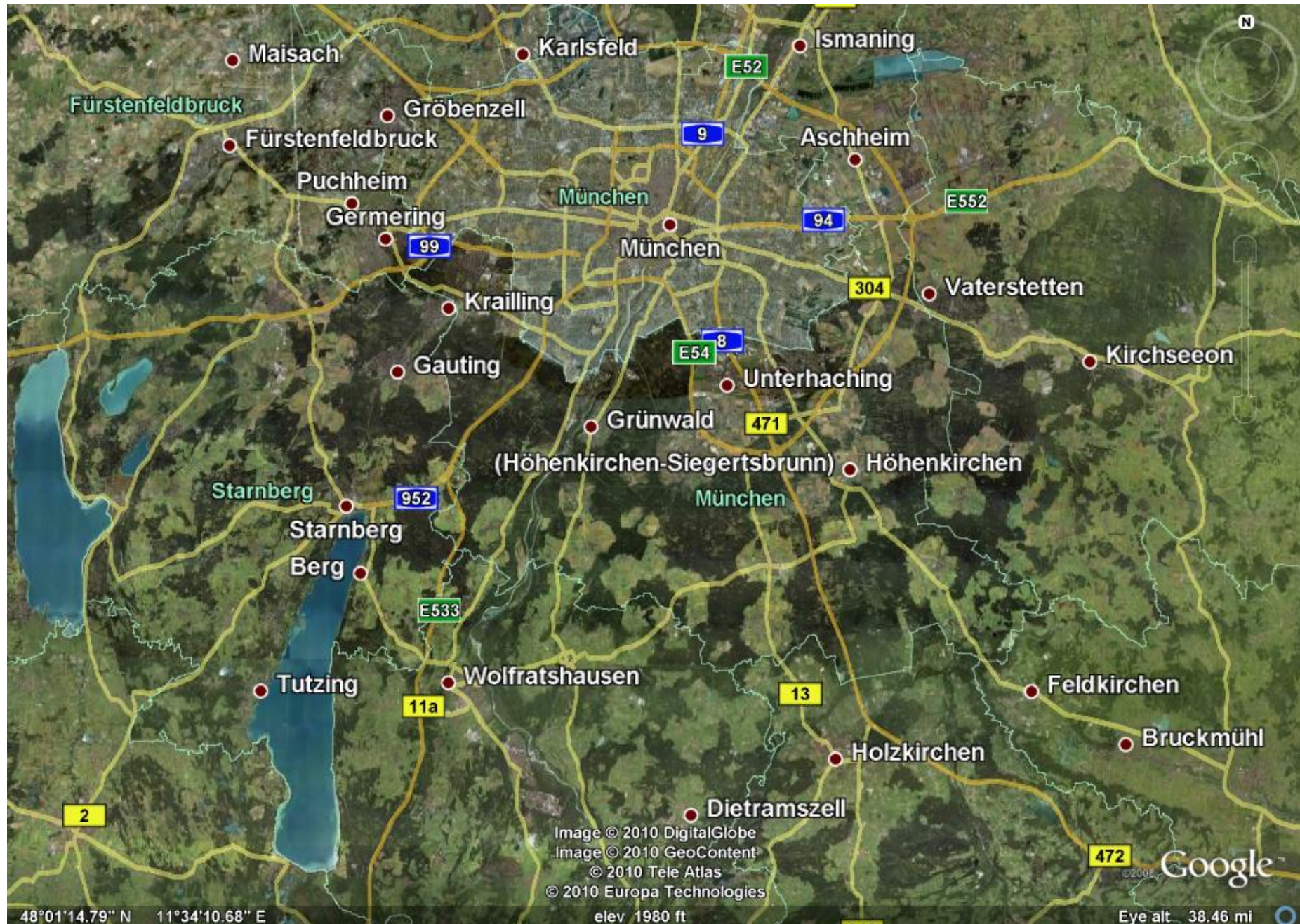
- Address: Föhringer Ring 6, 80805 München, Germany
- The Max-Planck-Institut für Physik is one of the almost 80 autonomous research institutes of the Max-Planck-Society. Founded in 1917 in Berlin, then as Kaiser-Wilhelm-Institut für Physik, with Albert Einstein as the director. It moved several times during its eventful history. In 1958 moved to Munich and it was expanded to be a Max-Planck-Institut für Physik und Astrophysik ("... for physics and astrophysics")



- ▶ Depending on the weather we could make on Wednesday afternoon a half day excursion (like a boat trip) on lake Starnberg
- ▶ Or a guided tour through the German Museum or the Residence
- ▶ or ...
- ▶ The conference dinner could be organized in a typical Bavarian style restaurant (for example the Seehaus in the English Garden or the Hofbräuhaus)
